

Making faces

Face painting

Mark making activity: creating masks with own designs.

You will need:

Small paper plates (1 per child), with holes cut out for eyes

Drawing materials

Wooden sticks

You might like to try the Face Painting activity sheet (A1) from the Booktime website first, to practise drawing designs on paper before making masks.

For an arts and crafts activity, ask the children to decorate paper plates with their own designs for face painting.

Children could copy designs from the book, or try drawing new designs (try zebra, sad clown, mouse or robot).

Once the plates have been decorated, tape craft sticks to the back so they can be used as masks.
